OPERATING & SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



Using the scraper





safety - extend blade protector pull the black slide to the

blade to put the scraper at safety

Remove blade protector

• firmly push away the black slide from the blade using both thumbs to remove the blade protector. Press lightly.



ATTENTION!

UNGER blades are razor-sharp. Always handle with greatest care!



Safety instructions:

- The UNGER glass scrapers with carbon blades, featuring 2 sharp edges, are perfect for removing bird droppings, paint, tape, stickers and postconstruction debris from the glass.
- Check if glass is scratch-resistant and suitable for scraper use. Unsuitable for use on Plexiglas, crown glass, solar glass, safety glass (ESG). Follow the manufacturer's care instructions
- Perform a scrape test in advance on an inconspicuous section
- · Before starting work, check the glass for damage and report it, if necessary
- . Check the blade for damage and change it, if necessary, or reverse it
- The **surface** to be scraped should always be **wet**
- It is best to use a **release agent**, e.g. "UNGER's Liquid"
- Always scrape in one direction! Never pull the scraper back – scratch risk!
- · After scraping, check if adhesive or stucco residues are stuck to blade. If necessary, change or reverse blade

Changing the blade



Open the body Turn or change the blade

- press green button deep inside • remove or turn the blade to open the body
 - blade has to fit both pins (arrows)

ATTENTION: Danger of injuring oneself!



Close body

- hold both sides of the body that a) both lateral noses hook in the
- b) three internal noses can click into the top side of the body
- · press the both halfs of the body, green button has to click into place audible



ATTENTION:

While changing and turning the blade hold scraper even (black slide at the top) avoid falling off the blade:
